Our mission is to uphold the highest standards of guardianship while empowering students to thrive academically and personally in the UK. We blend structured support with opportunities for cultural immersion, ensuring every student feels valued, respected, and prepared for success.

I. Foundational Aims

Student Welfare Assurance

- Operate purpose-built guardianship centre with 24/7 on-site staffing
- Maintain 1:3 daytime staff-student ratio across all facilities
- Implement structured daily wellbeing check-in

Cultural Transition Support

- Deliver monthly cultural orientation workshops
- Facilitate peer social integration activities

Safety Infrastructure

- UKAG adhere to the principles of the statutory 'Safer Recruitment' guidance for schools, and the National Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Children (NSPCC) 'Safer Recruitment' advice.
- Conduct fortnightly facility safety audits
- Provide emergency response training to all staff

IV. Facility Specifications

Our self-operated Bedford guardian centre provides:

- Accommodation: 7 shared bedrooms with privacy partitions and individual lockers (max 14 students)

- Privacy Protocol:

Bedroom-sharing requires written parental consent via digital authorization portal

Soundproof dividers between sleeping areas in shared rooms

Gender-segregated bathroom schedules upon request

- Security: Biometric entry system + motion-sensor lighting in all common areas

- Location: 20-minutes walk from Bedford Station (45 mins to London St Pancras)
